REGISTRATION & FEES

Register at diofdl.org/camp. If you do not have online access, contact your local church or the Diocesan Office for help. The fee includes housing, meals, program, t-shirt and secondary insurance. It does NOT include the camp store. Additional support is received from the Episcopal Diocese of Fond du Lac and the Val Burg Memorial Youth Work Fund. Register by May 13th for the lowest cost.

- Senior Camper..... \$360
- Middler or Junior Camper ... \$330
- Kinder Camper or Adult..... \$140

All fees increase \$25 after May 13th

A \$25 discount for the second and following children from the *same* family is available (1st child pays full fee, 2nd and additional children receive discount).

CONFIRMATION

Registrants receive a confirmation with “What to Bring”. A *Health History Form* is mailed to be completed by a parent (doctor review not required) and brought with you to camp check-in.



PAYMENTS

- Camper fee(s) are to be paid **in full** PRIOR to camp check-in. However, if receiving financial assistance, those may be received after camp.
- Payments may be made online at diofdl.org/camp or mailed to the Episcopal Diocese of Fond du Lac. Make sure to note camper name on check.
- Money for use at the camp store is collected at check-in. For safety, campers should NOT hold money at camp.



FINANCIAL AID

Cost is NOT a reason to miss camp!
If assistance is needed, please ask.

Many congregations, as well as community organizations, provide financial assistance for campers. Ask your priest, deacon, church leaders or others for assistance. The diocese does have campership assistance available if other sources are unable to meet the need. If diocesan aid is needed, contact the Diocesan Office at (920) 830-8866.
