## Number of Delegates

*Article III, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Diocese of Fond du Lac*

The **2022 Annual Convention** uses ASA reported on the parochial reports completed in 2021 of the year ending 12/31/2020. The chart of number of delegates presented is based on those numbers.

### LAY DELEGATES

- one delegate for each twenty-five of Average Sunday Attendance (ASA) according to the previous year's parochial report, or fraction thereof, in each organized congregation
  - no more than seven
  - no less than two
- Communicants in Good Standing and members of the congregation<sup>1</sup>
  - received Baptism and recorded
  - received Communion at least three times the preceding year
  - faithful in corporate worship, unless for good cause prevented
  - faithful in working, praying, and giving for the spread of the Kingdom of God.

### CLERGY DELEGATES

- Bishop Diocesan, Bishop Coadjutor, Bishop Suffragan, Bishop Retired
- Priest or Deacon Canonically Resident, in good standing.
- Right to vote if:
  - in parochial cure
  - in diocesan ecclesiastical office
  - is an instructor in a Church institution of learning
  - is engaged in work under the Executive Council
  - is Chaplain in the Armed Forces
  - is retired because of age or infirmity
  - Only for election of Bishop, Standing Committee, and Deputies and Alternate Deputies to General Convention, a member of a religious community
  - A Priest engaged in full-time academic study with the permission of the Bishop or Ecclesiastical Authority.
