Way of Love Evangelism Training

As part of equipping and sending people to share faith and invite their neighbors to join the Jesus Movement, the Episcopal Diocese of Fond du Lac is hosting an evangelism training led by the Presiding Bishop's Evangelism Team, in partnership with diocesan leaders. The focus will be how to integrate sharing into our daily life, the importance of evangelism, and why +1 is important in inviting people.

Our Homilist: The Very Rev. C. Patrick Perkins



The Very Rev. C. Patrick Perkins is Dean of the Cathedral of St. Paul, Fond du Lac. Dean Perkins is a trained classic musician and conductor. When he found himself assisting in pastoral care and Sunday School in a church in Mississippi after a pastor left, he realized a calling to ordained ministry. "My sense of a calling didn't come first from something in me, it came from the outside with people telling me that 'you're behaving like a minister, we see these gifts in you,'" he said. "Over a period of time, I often say that I backed into the ministry." After graduating from Nashotah House and ordination, Fr. Patrick was called to serve St. Mary's, Kansas City. He then was called by Bishop Gunter and the Cathedral Chapter to serve as Dean. "My calling is to assist congregations in the (re)development by promoting a Christian vision that is larger than life, greater than self and lasting forever."
